Coordinate Registration

The CCC will help parents/guardians register their kids on our district website. Please direct parents to the Kids Camp Parent Guide for more information. All forms will be filled out online.

Collect Camp Fees

Parents will pay a \$25 non-refundable deposit at registration. The CCC will collect the balance of the camp fees and give to your church treasurer. The CCC will also ensure that a CHURCH CHECK is brought to camp with the balance of all camp fees due. An email with information about who is registered from your church will be sent weekly once the registration process begins.

Secure Volunteers

The CCC will help to make sure there are volunteers to attend camp with your kids. See page 4 of this guide for the number of volunteers recommended. Also, make sure each volunteer has read the Kids Camp Volunteer Guide and has all the appropriate NazSafe certification and training for camp.

One-Day Camp

With the health situation today, we want to offer parents a one-day option for their kids if they are not comfortable with an overnight stay at camp. Saturday, July 24 (the Saturday of camp), will be open for kids to come and spend the day as campers. Any adult who brings the kids on that day will need to follow the same NazSafe certification as regular volunteers. To register their kids for one-day, simply fill out the regular online registration and select ONE-DAY CAMP. The cost for the one-day option is \$50, \$60, or \$70, following the same registration deadlines as regular registration.



CAMP RATES

Early Registration—\$195

Online registration completed and \$25 deposit paid on/ before June 15.

Regular Registration—\$210

Online registration completed and \$25 deposit received from June 16 through July 10.

***T-SHIRT SIZES CANNOT BE GUARANTEED AFTER JULY 10.

***The \$25 deposit is non-refundable.

Late Registration—\$230

Online registration completed and \$25 deposit paid from July 11 through July 23.

REGISTRATION

Step 1

Direct parents/guardians to **register** online at neokdisrict.org. Find camp registration by placing your cursor over EVENTS, then select Kids Camp 2021.

Step 2

Collect balance of camp fees from parent/guardian for each camper registered.

Step 3

Send balance of camp fees by church check for each camper registered to camp or request a payment link to pay online.

All steps must be completed on/before due date to secure registration price listed.

The district is offering a scholarship for all pastor's children.

PAYMENT AND FORMS

The balance of camp fees should be paid to your local church. You, as CCC, will send a **CHURCH CHECK** payable to **NEO SDMI** to camp. We will not accept personal checks for registration.



VOLUNTEERS

Costs

As a district, we are obligated to pay the campground the full price for everyone who attends camp, kids and adults alike. Our district leadership is very generous in supplementing the cost for our volunteers so it will not be a financial burden for them to serve at camp.

We try to maintain a 1:5 ratio between volunteers and campers. The cost for volunteers is \$100 according to the following schedule:

1-5 campers—1 volunteer at \$100

6-10 camper—2 volunteers at \$100 each

11-15 campers—3 volunteers at \$100 each

Any volunteer over the above schedule will pay the full price of \$195, if registered by July 10.

Any volunteer registered after July 10 will pay \$195, no matter how many campers are attending from their church.

Number of Volunteers

To ensure we have the proper number of volunteers for the amount of kids registered for camp, every church sending campers is **HIGHLY ENCOURAGED** to send at least 1 volunteer for every 5 campers. It is important to keep in mind the gender of the volunteer. If you are bringing 10 boys and 4 girls, please send 2 male counselors and 1 female counselor instead of 4 female counselors. This helps us make sure all kids are properly taken care of at camp.

Please do not let this discourage you from sending kids to camp. If you are having trouble finding adult volunteers, try joining with another church, so long as the final result ends with the encouraged amount of adult volunteers. If you do join with another church in your volunteer ratios, please let the camp registrar know so that he/she can coordinate rooming properly.

CHECK-IN

Check-in will be on Friday, July 23. As the schedule is completed, we will give more specific times for registration. Then you will be asked to select a check-in time. Each church should arrive at camp at their assigned check-in time. As you enter the campground, an NEO KidMin Team rep will be present to give you instructions and to pray with you. You will then follow the signs to the check-in site. Please have only 1 adult volunteer go into the check-in site to check your church in.

After you check in, you can then bring any kids who have medication in to give that medication to the camp nurse.

If, as the CCC, you are not attending camp, please pass this information on to your adult volunteers.

CHECK OUT

Camp is completed on Monday, July 26, again as the schedule is completed we will give more specific check out times. Please ensure there is someone at camp by this time to check your kids out.
