## CAMP RATES

### Early Registration—\$190

Online registration completed, including the \$25 deposit, on/before May 31.

### Regular Registration—\$200

Online registration completed, including the \$25 deposit, from June 1 through June 30.

**\*\*\*T-SHIRT SIZES CANNOT BE GUARANTEED AFTER JUNE 30.**

**\*\*\*The \$25 deposit is non-refundable.**

### Late Registration—\$210

Online registration completed from July 1 through July 15 for 1-3 Camp and July 22 for 4-6 Camp.

## PAYMENT

With the exception of the \$25 deposit, the camp fee **MUST** be paid to your church. Your Church Camp Coordinator will bring a church check with the balance of camp fees to camp. We will not accept personal checks at registration.

## REGISTRATION

### Step 1

**Register** online at [neokdistrict.org](http://neokdistrict.org). Find camp registration by placing your cursor over **EVENTS**, then select **Kids Camp 2022**.

### Step 2

**Complete** all forms online and **pay** the \$25 deposit at the time of registration.

### Step 3

Give balance of camp fees to your Church Camp Coordinator.

**All steps must be completed on/before due date to secure registration price listed.**

## WHAT TO BRING

### Toiletries

Towels (swim & shower)

Dress modestly  
No spaghetti straps (Tank tops must have wide strap.)  
No short shorts  
No halter tops  
No sagging pants  
No bare midriffs  
No net shirts  
Tennis shoes  
Water shoes  
Swimsuit (A shirt and shorts [or swim trunks for guys] must be worn over swim suits to and from the pool.)  
Girls: must be a one piece swimsuit or tankini only  
Guys: swim trunks, no speedos  
Hoodie (It's crazy but sometimes it gets chilly in the evenings, yes, even in July.)

### Other

Bible  
Twin sheets/sleeping bag  
Pillow  
Blanket  
Small flashlight  
Garbage bags for dirty clothes

## MEDICATION

All medication must be turned in to the camp nurse upon arrival at camp. The nurse will be available at registration.

All medication must be in their original container with dosages clearly printed on the bottle. (Check with your pharmacy, they may be able to prepare a bottle especially for camp.) The medication should be in a zip lock bag and labeled with the child's name and church name.

Over the counter meds are available through the nurse, so there is no need to send these to camp.

Kids or adult volunteers should pick up meds following breakfast on Monday morning.

## DEVICE FREE ZONE

Please do not send any electronic devices (including cell phones) to camp. If a camper arrives at camp with a device, they will be asked to check it in with the camp director at the beginning of the weekend. The device will be returned to the camper before they leave camp on Monday.

This is an opportunity for us to give campers a device-free weekend where they can focus on hearing from Jesus Christ and building relationships.

## SECURITY

Your child's safety is of the utmost importance to us. All volunteers are screened and follow Nazarene Safe guidelines. Anyone visiting the campground during camp must check in at the office immediately upon arrival.

If your child needs to leave the campground during camp, a parent/guardian must submit a signed authorization with details explaining who will pick the child up, time of departure and return (if applicable). Only the person listed on this authorization will be able to take the child from the campground before the end of camp.

## EMERGENCY

In the event of an emergency the camp nurse will assess the situation and make a decision, along with the camp director and child's sponsor, about further medical needs. Parents/Guardians will be notified if the nurse feels the child needs to be taken to the emergency room for any reason.

If you have an emergency at home and need to contact your child, please contact your Church Camp Coordinator or the adult volunteer that is at camp with your child.

## MAIL CALL

We encourage you to send a note to your camper!

Mail will be "delivered" on Saturday or Sunday. Please give notes to your adult volunteer who will ensure they are delivered properly.

Label mail with camper's first and last name, church, and the day you want it delivered.

## HEALTH SAFETY

We are implementing additional safety precautions in light of the present health situation.

- **Smaller groups:** The campers will be divided into 2 groups so there will be smaller groups of kids in each activity.
- **Sleeping:** Campers will sleep "head-to-toe" in their cabins. That means one camper will sleep with their head at one end of the bed and the next camper will sleep with their head at the opposite end of the bed.
- **One-Day Camp:** We are offering a one-day option for parents that are not comfortable with their kids staying over night. Check with your CCC (Church Camp Coordinator) for more info.
